Booking for all clubs will be available on the Arbor app and will open at **6pm** on **Monday 20**th **October**; when a club is full it will automatically close for further bookings. If you try to book your child onto more than one of the clubs, your child will automatically be allocated the first club that is coming up in the school year. This will mean that your child will be cancelled off the lists of any other clubs requested and you will be advised accordingly.

Spaces are limited and will therefore be allocated on a first come first served basis. When booking, you will be committing your child to all of the sessions. Once booked, if your child is unable to attend a session, there is an expectation that you will inform the lead member of staff.
